

This is really a joyful moment for Nollywood star actress, Wumi

Toriola as her debut cinema movie, Queen
Lateefah, crossed the N300 million mark at the box office, making the movie to ranked among the top 7 Nollywood's highest box office earner which is really a big boost for her acting career.

Queen Lateefah, the Nigerian cinematic

sensation, has grossed over N350 million at the box office since its release on September 27.

The film is now the seventh highestgrossing Nollywood movie to date and holds the distinction of being the topearning release outside of the lucrative December period, unadjusted for inflation. This box office success, as reported by **Nigerian Box Office**, underscores the increasing appetite for Nollywood's homegrown stories.

Joining the ranks of blockbusters such as

Ajosepo, which earned N257.2 million, and Ajakaju, with N252.8 million, Queen Lateefah has quickly established itself as a high performer within Nollywood's non December releases. Please share with Edugist a little about yourself and your background.

I am a first-class graduate of Statistics from the University of Lagos and the first best graduating student of the department. I was the Director of Studies for the National Association of Mathematics Students, Unilag Chapter. I hail from Osun State but I have mostly lived in Lagos and Ogun states. I have two brothers who are both graduates of the University of Lagos. Professionally, I am a Data Analyst and Data Scientist, a career path I started in 2020.

What motivated you to pursue a degree in statistics?

I have always loved numbers and computation. I applied to study mathematics at the University of Lagos. By the end of 100 level, we were told to select a field in mathematics to specialise in. I did a little research and learned about Data Analytics as a career and the importance of a degree in Statistics for this field. So, I

decided that I wanted to specialise in Statistics. In 2022, Statistics was finally accredited to become a department at the University of Lagos.

Were there any courses that you found particularly challenging?

Many courses were challenging. I particularly found stochastic processes difficult, and the ASUU strike in the middle of the semester did not help matters. However, I am glad everything turned out fine eventually.

What significant challenges did you encounter during your study?

My journey was not all rosy. I had moments of financial constraints and burnout. There were also several strikes which were not encouraging. When I started at UNILAG, my CGPA was not at a first-class level. It wasn't until my final year before I entered the first class, a feat made possible with three consecutive 5.0/5.0 semester GPAs.

Did you participate in any internship during your study?

My department did not have a structure for industrial training. However, I actively participated in several extracurricular activities. In 2021, I was a Data Science tutor for the Google Developer Student Club. In the same year, I did an apprenticeship with Datagenius Consulting as a Data and Research Analyst. In 2022, I was selected for the ALX-T Udacity Nanodegree and successfully became a Room Fellow.

In my final year in school, I was a Student Ambassador for Tableau, during which I hosted and cohosted several workshops to teach Data Analytics and Tableau. I also actively participated in several hackathons, including the 10Alytics African Data Hackathon where I came 6th place out of about 1500 participants. Did you win any

Did you win any scholarships for your study?

Unfortunately, I didn't win any scholarships during my period at the University of Lagos.

Do you have any role models you look up to?

When I gained

admission to the University of Lagos, I heard about Omotuyi Öyindamola who made the headlines for being the overall bestgraduating student at the University of Lagos and achieving a perfect CGPA of 5.0/5.0 in Systems Engineering. I was inspired by the feat of this lady. My brothers also graduated from UNILAG and performed excellently well. I look up to them as role models and I knew I was going to do my best during my stay in school.

Has any lecturer contributed to your ease of navigating our academics?

My course advisor and project supervisor, Dr. Mary Akinyemi, was one of my mentors during my stay at the University of Lagos. She taught me to push harder rather than achieve the barest minimum. With her support, I was able to present my project topic: "Evaluation of Autism Spectrum Disorder Diagnosis Using Machine Learning Models" as a research paper at the 9th Annual Conference on Mathematical Sciences and Optimization.

What are your long-term career goals?

I am interested in furthering my education after my bachelor's degree. Currently, I am in search of scholarships for a master's degree.




My long-term goal is to continue and advance my career in data. If I were asked 10 years ago about my career goals, I would have likely said something different. However, I am certain that I will be excellent wherever I find myself.

What advice would you offer students who would love to replicate this success in STEM fields?

I have three pieces of advice. The first thing I would say is to enjoy your course. I realise that it is easier to do better when you have a passion for what you are doing. Research about your course, and don't limit yourself to what you learn in class. The second thing is for you to start studying early. Personally, I am against reading a week or a day before the exam. Start from the first day and keep practising. Never pile up. The last thing I would say is to manage your time wisely. It is a good idea to participate in extracurricular activities for career development. You can also make use of productivity tools like Pomodoro, To-dolist/Schedule apps, and so on. However, ensure you manage your time properly so that the activities don't affect your academics.



Ugo Ugochukwu, a Nigerian-American driver born on April 23, 2007, in New York, USA, is the son of former Nigerian queen, Oluchi Onweagba.

He began his racing journey in 2014 by competing in the Micro ROK Cup USA. He quickly made his mark, winning his first American championship title that year. His exceptional talent and charisma propelled him to claim two more American championships in 2014 and 2015. In 2016, Ugo expanded his horizons by competing in European series, securing second place in the Mini ROK Cup and Mini 60 Italian Championship. The year 2017 was a breakthrough, as he won the Mini X30 IAME All Star Finals and the IAME International X30 Mini Cup, showcasing his prowess on the global stage.

Ugo continued to dominate in 2018, earning the title of Junior ROK-Challenge of the Americas

champion and finishing as vicechampion in the Junior ROK Florida Winter Tour. Despite the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020, he remained focused and was signed by Zak Brown, CEO of McLaren F1 Racing Team, as the first member of the McLaren Junior driver program. Before transitioning to singleseater racing in 2022 with Carlin Racing in the British F4 Championship, Ugo concluded his karting career on a high note by finishing second in the OK Senior WSK Euro Series in 2021. Afolayan was reported to have made this revelation while speaking at the 2024 Zuma Film Festival which took place in Abuja.

Afolayan said that Netflix had stopped commissioning new Nigerian originals and that unlike many of his colleagues, he was fortunate to have secured a third season for his hit series 'Anikulapo' before the platform made the decision.

He added that some of his colleagues were not that lucky as other Nollywood projects in development were cancelled.

He described their leaving as a big blow to the industry and also saw it as a wake-up call for the movie





Life As A Showbiz Promoter

Billiamin Olabanji popularly known as Billy Que in the entertainment circle is one of the leading Nigerian artistes and showbiz promoters in the United Kingdom. The affable young man has carved a niche for himself with his UK and European Tours which he frequently packaged for artistes, more especially young and talented Nigerian artistes and DJs which has tremendously helped in showcasing and exposing them to international audiences. In this exclusive interview, Billy Que speaks about his experience working with Hip-hop and Fuji Artistes, his contribution to the ever growing popularity of the Afrobeats genre, his visions for his brand among other topical issues.

Can you tell us about yourself?

My name is Billiamin Olabanji. I am an Artistes and Event Promoter based in London, United Kingdom. I'm the CEO and founder of Billy Que Entertainment. And within the industry, people call me Billy Que.

How did you get to be a show promoter?

When I was young, I used to be a party rider. I like going out a lot. I love to attend parties and have fun. And I always organize parties for friends and families. So one day, I just asked myself why don't I start making money with these parties and gatherings I do for people when I noticed people are making money off it as well. This was how I became a promoter and event planner.

So far, what has been your biggest failure, and what did you learn from the experience?

Organizing an event and it was later canceled due to artiste missing flight on the day of the event. So I have learnt never to make such a mistake again, as in getting an artiste to land on the day of the event. It's just too risky. I will never try such a thing again.

What's one thing about your career that you didn't expect?

I didn't expect my promotional deals with Hip-hop / Afrobeats artistes as well as Fuji artistes, like proper indigenous music artists. It's kind of funny how I've been able to handle the two genres effectively.

Between promotions of Fuji Artistes and the Afrobeats or Hip-hop acts, which do you prefer or which is easier to package and handle?

Hip-hop artistes are easier to package because it involves less logistics.

You tend to love Fuji music and promoting Fuji Artistes. What led to this?

As a Yoruba boy. I like my culture. That is why I like promoting Fuji music.

Who are the Fuji Artistes you've worked with?

Too many Fuji artists have worked with. From King Wasiu Ayinde, Wasiu Alabi Pasuma, Sulaimon Alao Malaika, Saheed Osupa, Obesere, Taye Currency, Adewale Ayuba, Remi Aluko, and so many fast rising upcoming Fuji artistes.

Tell us about your first music promotion.

My first music promotion was for Qdot, a hip-hop artistes in 2011.

Which will you describe as your toughest event?

First major concert for Davido in 2013.

What's the biggest challenge you're facing in your career right now, and how are you tackling it?

My challenge right now is risking a lot of my personal money to invest on a big project without having major sponsors or part sponsors. So I'm always looking for sponsors to execute my big projects. Now, I do more of marketing of my shows to brands and sponsors and the responses are encouraging.


What's the most important lesson you've learned in your career so far?

In this line of our business, one must have integrity because it's a business that largely deals with money.

Artistes are known to be eccentric and very unpredictable. How do you manage their excesses?

Artistes are really not predictable, most of them are ungrateful once they get the fame or too much money coming in for







In this line of our business, one must have integrity because it's a business that largely deals with money.

My own is to promote and do whatever business I have with them. I don't really expect favours or help from them. I do strictly business with them most times so I don't get disappointed anytime they start their ungrateful acts.

Can you share with us the weirdest thing an artiste has ever done to you in this music promotion business?

Promoting an artist from scratch. From when nobody knows him at all and when he gets known and gets fame, the artiste doesn't appreciate me or my effort anymore. Like 2 to 3 artistes have done this to me. But I

don't want to start mentioning names.

In your opinion, what's the most important strength or personality trait someone would need to be successful in your job?

You must be ready to sacrifice your personal life and time. The job takes a lot of my personal time, in fact that includes my family time. If you want to be a promoter like me, you must be ready to give 60% of your personal time on the business and 40% of your family time. You must also know how to relate with people because in this promotion job, you meet a lot of people, I mean different types of people with all sorts of characters.

How much time do you spend on social media each day?

I literally lived on social media because I need to keep abreast of happenings in the entertainment industry. I can tell you I'm on social media or online for 18hrs. In fact, it's only when I'm sleeping that I am offline.

Is there anything you wish you could change about the social media world?

Yes of course! Cyber bullying. I don't like that on social media. People need to stop that.

What is your dream project?

It's to host my own show at the 20 thousand capacity 02 Arena in the UK.

What trends do you see

emerging in the Entertainment industry, and how impactful do you consider them to be?

All those funny skit makers. Many are very creative and informative. They are giving people joy and hope to live life, and also taking stress off the people especially at this difficult time.

What are your long-term professional goals within the Entertainment industry?

My long term goal is to own my own nightclub or an event center.

How do you spend quality time with your family despite your tight schedules and trips around the world?

I tried to make up for the times I'm not around whenever I have the opportunity to be with my family. I spend time with my wife and kids whenever I am home with them because once I am out like this, I am in a different world.

What does your morning routine look like?

Due to the nature of my job, I work most of the night, so in the morning, trust me I am still sleeping and trying to relax.

Why do some people call you Billy 60-40?

Haaaa haaa (laughing out loud)! That's my sharing formulae with most of the artistes I worked with on events or shows we do together. After taking our costs invested on a project. I give them 60%, I take 40%.

What advice do you have for young people out there who want to take up music promotions as a career?

Music promotion is a good career. My advice to young people out there is to get focused and know exactly what you really want to be in the music industry, if it's DJ, MC, Event Planner or Club Promoter, just focus on your craft and do it well. Be humble and honest. Integrity really matters a lot.

Let people know you for one thing. It really goes a long way.



SEAN DIDDY COMBS His Rise To Fame + Ongoing Legal Battles



ip-hop music mogul and showbiz entrepreneur, Sean "Diddy" Combs amazing grass to grace story has taking a new turn with the multiple court cases that is currently hanging on his neck. Combs was indicted on multiple charges, including sex trafficking and racketeering, in September, 2024.

After facing multiple lawsuits in recent months alleging sexual assault and other crimes, Sean Combs was indicted Sept. 17 on charges of sex trafficking by force, racketeering conspiracy, fraud or coercion and transporting for prostitution. Combs' attorney, Marc Agnifilo, called it an "unjust prosecution," and said his client is "an innocent man with nothing to hide."

The recent charges are not the first controversies that the music mogul and entrepreneur have faced over the years. Combs have attempted to rebrand himself as "Brother Love, but he has a prolonged history of allegations of violence, dating back to the Nineties. He's never been convicted of a serious crime, but has repeatedly been accused of having violent encounters with everyone from his exes Ventura and Gina Huynh (who alleged physical abuse in 2019) to executive Steve Stoute and rappers like J. Cole and Drake. There was a time when an invitation to a party hosted by Sean "Diddy Combs was one of the most soughtafter tickets in the entertainment industry.

With guest lists that included Justin Bieber, Mariah Carey, Paris Hilton and Jennifer Lopez, it was a chance to rub shoulders with some of the biggest celebrities. Jay-Z and Beyoncé even released new music at his events.

"The reason he was such a superstar


is because all he thinks about is Diddy. From the minute he wakes up until the minute he goes to bed," Mr Shuter told BBC News. "Diddy's hobby is Diddy." In the Los Angeles area, the rapper lived on what has become known as Beverly Hills's most expensive street.

The high fences allow celebrities to hide from prying eyes. Hugh Hefner's Playboy mansion sits a few doors down. Combs's mansion in Beverly Hills was one of several venues he used to host his annual "White Party", a flagship event which he held from 1998 to 2009.

He began the parties in New York's exclusive Hamptons area with a strict all-

white dress code, bringing together East Hampton's old-money elite and the rising stars of hip hop. Combs once described the parties as a way to break down racial and generational barriers.

But the hottest party of the year was a "facade" that allowed "sinister" conduct, a recent lawsuit alleges. Singer Cassie, who dated the rapper off-and-on for nearly a decade starting in 2007, accused the mogul in a lawsuit of controlling every aspect of her life, forcing her to take excessive amounts of drugs, have sex with other men, beating her for years and threatening her - and those in her circle - when she tried



to leave the relationship. In a lawsuit - which started an avalanche of accusations against the rapper - the singer said while dating Combs she realised he had a "tremendously loyal network" that would do anything he asked. Combs's fall from grace has been swift, with an extensive federal criminal case charging him in a sex trafficking and racketeering conspiracy. More than a dozen civil lawsuits have also been filed, accusing the music mogul of assaults, rape and sexual extortion. One lawyer said he represents more than 100 alleged victims who claim they were sexually abused. The Harlem-born rapper has repeatedly denied any wrongdoing, whether in relation to the criminal or civil allegations.

He is set to go on trial in May 2025.

Who is Diddy?

Sean "Diddy" Combs who has gone by the names Puff Daddy, P Diddy and Love is an American rapper, actor and entrepreneur who founded an entertainment empire, including Bad Boy Records, the clothing label Sean John and Revolt TV, which has since announced a new ownership structure. Combs was also the face of alcohol brand Cîroc Vodka, in a deal that ended acrimoniously.

Born in Harlem in New York City,

Combs was just three years old when his father Melvin Combs was murdered after being mistaken for an informant during a drug deal gone wrong.

Combs was nicknamed Puffy in his youth due to his habit of huffing and puffing whenever he was angry. (He changed his middle name from John to Love in 2021.)

Combs dropped out of Howard University in 1990 to pursue an internship at Uptown Records. It would be a rapid rise at Uptown; before long, he was promoted to an A&R executive and later, vice-president.

Uptown has been home to artists such as Mary J Blige, Heavy D & The Boyz, and then Combs is said to have discovered the Notorious BIG, aka Biggie Smalls (real name was Christopher Wallace).
But Combs was fired from Uptown

But Combs was fired from Uptown Records in 1993 by its founder, Andre Harrell.

Combs founded Bad Boy Records in 1993, a label that represented some of the biggest names in hip hopincluding artists like Notorious B.I.G. and Usher. In 1998, he created the Sean John clothing line that later became a cultural phenomenon. From there, he dipped into fragrances, alcohol and even set up a media company, becoming the host of multiple reality shows where he would discover new talent and make people stars.

In 1995, Biggie dominated the charts, making him Bad Boy's premier star.

But on March 9, 1997, Biggie was murdered in an unsolved case amid an East Coast-West Coast feud. He was 24 years old.


A few months later, Combs released his debut album No Way Out under the moniker Puff Daddy. The album included the Grammy-Awardwinning single I'll Be Missing You, a tribute to Biggie, which featured his widow Faith Evans and sampled Every Breath You Take by The Police.

No Way Out won Best Rap Album at the Grammys, and Combs snagged Best Rap Performance by a Duo or Group for I'll Be Missing You. He also dabbled in the silver screen at times: he played a death row inmate in 2001's Monster's Ball, starring Oscar-winner Halle Berry; a record executive in the comedy Get Him to the Greek in 2010 opposite Russell Brand; and he was a sports agent in the 2014 football drama Draft Day.





Award and the endowment to every young girl who cares to dream.

President Bola Ahmed Tinubu, represented by Minister of State for Education, Suwaiba Ahmad, reiterated his administration's commitment to providing an enabling environment for productivity in tertiary institutions, through funding and infrastructural support. House of Representatives Speaker Tajudeen Abbas, who also received the Fellowship Award of the institution, said a bill that would end dichotomy between university and polytechnic education was underway to stop discrimination against polytechnic graduates. The Rector, Dr Ibraheem Abdul, said no fewer than 8,139 students graduated.

Canada Now Permits International Students To Work 24 Hours

Canada has increased the permissible work hours for eligible international students during academic terms from 20 to 24 hours per week. "Immigrat ion will be crucial to addressing our labour shortage.

By allowing international students to work more while they study, we can help ease pressing needs in many sectors across the country, while providing more opportunities for international students to gain valuable Canadian work experience and continue contributing to our short-term recovery and long-term prosperity."




